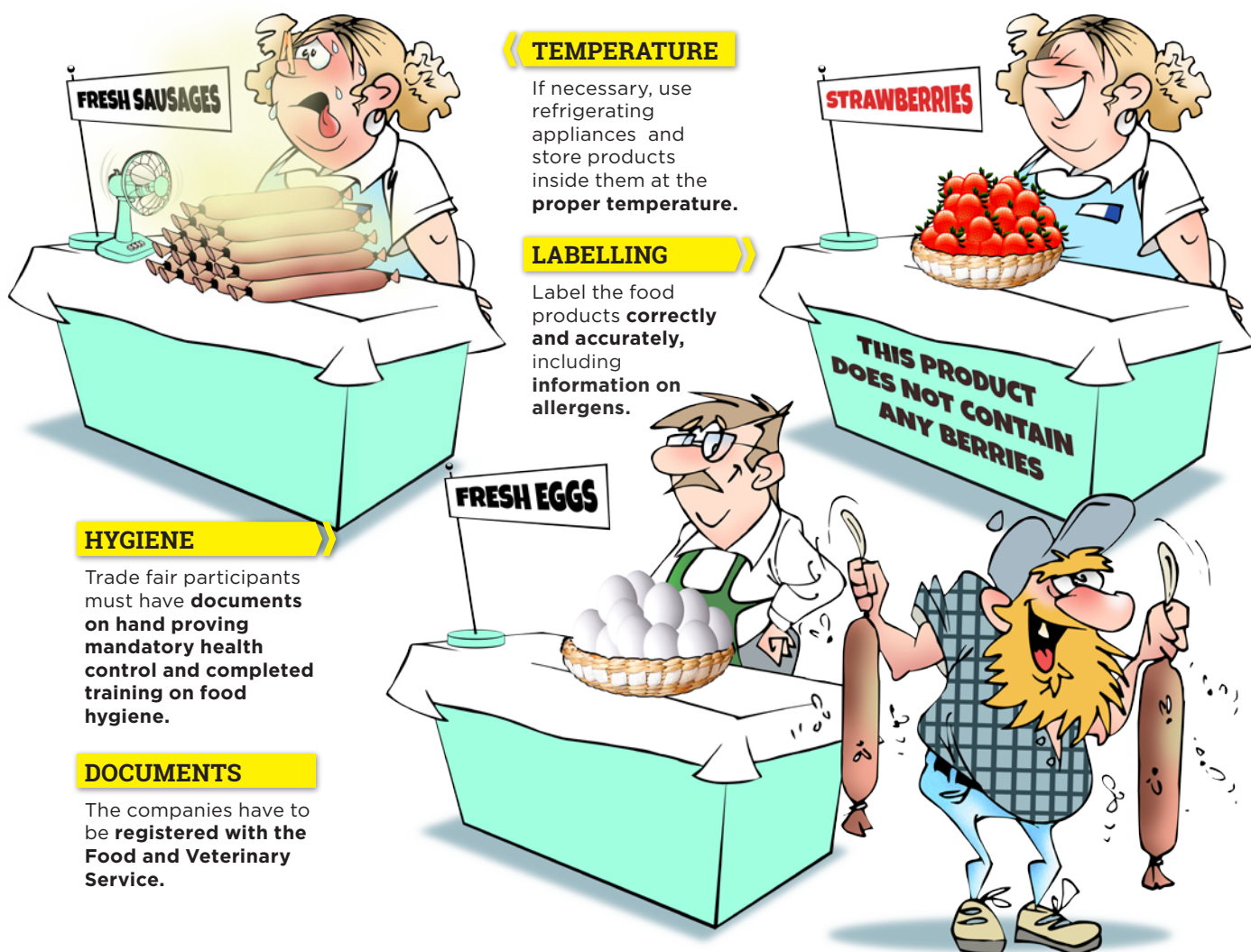


# FOOD AND DRINKS AT THE TRADE FAIR

**Worthwhile information to all trade fair participants planning to sell food or beverages, or offer these products for tasting during the fair!**

We would like to remind you that, upon identifying violations, the Food and Veterinary Service (FVS) inspector may terminate food distribution and/or apply a penalty.



## TEMPERATURE

If necessary, use refrigerating appliances and store products inside them at the **proper temperature.**

## LABELLING

Label the food products **correctly and accurately**, including **information on allergens.**

## HYGIENE

Trade fair participants must have **documents on hand proving mandatory health control and completed training on food hygiene.**

## DOCUMENTS

The companies have to be **registered with the Food and Veterinary Service.**

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION!

### About the Law

When a company signs a contract-application for participation in a trade fair, it resolves to abide by the normative acts of the Republic of Latvia and Rules for Participation.

### About Food

The food chain is one of the most strictly regulated business areas in Latvia and people involved have to be ready to abide by the EU regulations and decisions, Latvian laws, and Regulations of the Cabinet of Ministers.

### About the Food and Veterinary Service (FVS)

Inspectors of the Food and Veterinary Service control the food chain during trade fairs at Ķīpsala to ensure that:

- companies are abiding by hygiene requirements;
- food products are stored according to the product manufacturer's instructions;
- food products are properly labelled;
- the distributed food is suitable for consumption - that it is not spoiled or expired.
